A BILL TO AMEND THE CORPORATIONS TAXATION
ACT.

NOTE.

The Corporations Taxation Act in its present form only taxes express companies, and this Bill is intended to tax companies which carry on express business whether they are solely engaged in such business or not.

An Act to amend The Corporations Taxation Act.

(Assented to _____, 1925.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Corporations Taxation Act Amendment Act, 1925.*"

2. *The Corporations Taxation Act*, being chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by striking out section 7, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"7. Every company transacting or being concerned in an express business in Alberta pursuant to any traffic arrangement or agreement with a railway, express or other company, or otherwise, shall pay the following taxes, that is to say:

- "(a) Ten dollars for each place other than a city or town with a population of over one hundred in which such company has any office, branch or agency for the transaction of express business;
- "(b) Fifty dollars for each incorporated town having a population of less than fifteen hundred in which such company has any office, branch or agency for the transaction of express business;
- "(c) One hundred dollars for each incorporated town having a population of fifteen hundred or more and for each incorporated city having a population of less than five thousand in which such company has any office, branch or agency for the transaction of express business;
- "(d) Two hundred dollars for each incorporated city having a population of five thousand or over other than the City of Edmonton or the City of Calgary, in which such company has any office, branch, or agency for the transaction of express business."

3. This Act shall come into force on the.....day of.....1925.
