- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Amusements Tax Act Amendment Act, 1925."
- 2. The Amusements Tax Act, being chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by adding as section 10a immediately after section 10 thereof the following:

  "10a. Every owner of a place of amusement failing to make any return to the Provincial Secretary required by this Act, shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than twenty-five dollars and not more than two hundred dollars for each offence, and in default of payment of the fine and costs to imprisonment for not more than six months."
