# BILL

No. 45 of 1925.

An Act to amend The Amusements Tax Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1925.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Amusements Tax Act Amendment Act, 1925.*"

**2.** *The Amusements Tax Act*, being chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by adding as section 10*a* immediately after section 10 thereof the following:

**"10*a*.** Every owner of a place of amusement failing to make any return to the Provincial Secretary required by this Act, shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than twenty-five dollars and not more than two hundred dollars for each offence, and in default of payment of the fine and costs to imprisonment for not more than six months."
