An Act to amend The Workmen's Compensation Act (Accident Fund).

H IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Workmen's Compensation Act (Accident Fund) Amendment Act, 1925."
- **2.** Section 34 of *The Workmen's Compensation Act (Accident Fund)*, being chapter 177 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by adding immediately after subsection (1) and as subsections (1a) and (1b), the following:
- ing:
 "(1a) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this Act,
 when a workman is frost-bitten in the course of his employment, such occurrence shall be deemed to be an accident arising out of and in the course of his employment
 within the meaning of this Act.
- "(1b) The preceding subsection shall be deemed to have been in effect from the last day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-four."
- 3. Schedule 1 of the said Act is hereby struck out, and the following substituted:
- Class 1: Employment incidental to or connected with coal mining, other than coal mining by the removal of the overlying strata;
- Class 2: Employment incidental to or connected with the operation of coke ovens;
- Class 3: Employment incidental to or connected with the operation of briquetting plants;
- Class 4: Employment incidental to or connected with mining other than coal mining;
- Class 5: Employment of employees of workmen in or about mines;
- Class 6: Employment incidental to or connected with coal mining by the removal of the overlying strata.
