A BILL TO VALIDATE CERTAIN ASSESSMENTS
MADE BY THE HAIL INSURANCE BOARD
OF ALBERTA.

NOTE.

Certain assessments made under the provisions of *The Municipal Hail Insurance Act* were declared invalid by the Supreme Court on the grounds that notice of the assessment was not sent to the registered owner of certain lands.

This Bill is intended to validate the assessments made under the provisions of *The Municipal Hail Insurance Act* in the years 1919 to 1924 inclusive.

An Act to Validate certain Assessments made by the
Hail Insurance Board of Alberta.

(Assented to _____, 1925.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. The assessments made pursuant to or purporting to be made by any municipal district pursuant to the provisions of *The Municipal Hail Insurance Act* and the provisions of *The Municipal District Act* affecting hail insurance in the years one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, and one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, or in any of such years and each and every of such assessments and the respective taxes or rates levied or purporting to be levied by any municipal district pursuant to the said provisions, are hereby validated and confirmed and declared to be and to have been at all times since such assessments and levies were made legal, valid and binding upon the persons so assessed and chargeable in the manner provided in said Acts and a charge against the land with respect to which such assessments were made and such taxes or rates were levied respectively; and neither such assessments or levies nor any of them shall be open to question in any Court on any ground whatever.
