Most Gracious Sovereign:

W HEREAS it appears by Messages from the Honourable the Administrator of the Government of the Province of Alberta, Horace Harvey, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, and the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, and the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, 1925."
- 2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole two hundred and twenty-five thousand, one hundred and ninety-four dollars and sixty-five cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, not otherwise provided for and set forth in schedule A to this Act.

- 3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole twenty million, two hundred and eleven thousand, four hundred and ninety-nine dollars and sixty-nine cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, not otherwise provided for and set forth in schedule B to this Act.
- 4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole five million, nine hundred and forty-one thousand, two hundred and ninety-four dollars towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, up to the date of the final passage of the Estimates for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, not otherwise provided for and set forth in schedule C to this Act.
- 5. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
- 6. This Act shall come into force upon the day on which it is assented to.
