A BILL TO AMEND THE BEE DISEASES ACT, 1924.

NOTE.

This Bill extends the provisions of section 7 of the Act to forbid the keeping of bees imported into Alberta otherwise than in combless packages, and to forbid the keeping by any person within the Province of hives or equipment except metal ones.

H IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Bee Diseases Act, 1924, Amendment Act, 1925."

2. The Bee Diseases Act, 1924, being chapter 21 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, is amended by striking out section 7, and substituting therefor the following:
"7.—(1) All bees imported into Alberta otherwise than

"7.—(1) All bees imported into Alberta otherwise than in combless packages containing no brood, honeycomb or honey, and all bees imported into Alberta without a certificate of health issued by an authorized Government bee inspector stating that such bees are free from contagious or infectious disease, and all bees amongst which contagious or infectious disease exists, are hereby declared to be in quarantine upon the premises of their owner who shall within three days of the receipt of the bees, or of the occurrence of the disease as the case may be, notify the department, and shall not permit any of such bees or their honey or their hives or the appliances used in connection therewith, to be removed from his premises until the department or an inspector has given him permission so to do.

"(2) No hives, frames, combs or other equipment for the housing or care of bees, or honey that has been used previously for that purpose, which have been imported into Alberta, except those made of metal that has been thoroughly sterilized before shipping, shall be kept by any person within the Province."
