An Act to amend The Optometry Act.

(Assented to 1926.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as “*The Optometry Act Amendment Act, 1926.*”
- 2. *The Optometry Act*, being chapter 77 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1921, is amended as to section 10 thereof by adding thereto as subsection (3) the following:
“(3) A certificate under the hand of the Registrar of the Association to the effect that any person is or is not registered under this Act, shall be *prima facie* evidence of such fact, without proof of the signature on such certificate, and without proof of the fact that the person signing the same occupies the position of Registrar of the Association.”
