An Act to amend *The Venereal Diseases' Prevention Act*.

(Assented to _____, 1926.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Venereal Diseases' Prevention Act Amendment Act, 1926*."

2. *The Venereal Diseases' Prevention Act*, being chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to subsection (1) of section 3*a* by striking out paragraph (a) thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"(a) If any person is under arrest or in custody on a charge of any offence against section 216 of *The Criminal Code* (procuring—living on earnings of prostitution) or of keeping a common bawdy house under section 228 of the same or of being found in a common bawdy house under section 229 of the same or of being an inmate of a common bawdy house under section 229*a* of the same or of being a loose idle or disorderly person or vagrant under section 238*i* and 239 of the same (common prostitute or nightwalker) or under sections 238*l* and 239 of the same (living on the avails of prostitution) then if a justice is credibly informed and believes that such person is infected with or has been infected with or exposed to infection from venereal disease, he shall order that such person shall be physically examined by a medical practitioner appointed by the Provincial Board of Health and in the manner and to the extent prescribed by the regulations and at such place as may be directed by the justice."

3. Section 3*a* of the said Act is amended as to subsection (2) thereof by striking out the word "section" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "subsection."
