HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Stock Inspection Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1926."
- **2.** The Stock Inspection Act, 1922, being chapter 69 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, is amended by adding as section 20a, immediately after section 20 thereof, the following:
- "20a.—(1) Every person other than a licensed butcher, who slaughters any head of cattle for meat purposes, shall retain possession of the hide of such animal for a period of ten days thereafter, and shall during such period, produce such hide for examination by any officer of the Alberta Provincial Police Force who may demand to see the same:

"Provided, however, that any hide may be disposed of within such period upon receipt of written authority from any such officer.
