An Act respecting Holograph Wills.

(Assented to _____, 1926)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts
as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Holograph Wills Act."
2. Notwithstanding any other statutory provisions, a holograph will written and signed by the testator himself shall be valid if not made, acknowledged, attested or subscribed in the presence of or by any witness.
3. This Act shall be deemed to have been in force from the fifteenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six.
4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
