An Act to amend Chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, being an Act to empower the Medicine Lake Collieries, Limited, to construct and operate a colliery railway.

WHEREAS, Medicine Lake Collieries, Limited, has presented a petition praying for the amendment of an Act empowering it to construct and operate a colliery railway, being Chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioner;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That section 5 of the said Act be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor: "5. The construction of the railway hereby authorized

"5. The construction of the railway hereby authorized shall be commenced within four years and shall be completed within six years from the date of the coming into force of this Act, and section 70 of *The Railway Act* (Alberta) shall not apply to the said company."

2. This Act shall come into force upon the day it is assented to.
