An Act to amend The Produce Merchants Act, 1922.

(Assented to _____, 1927.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Produce Merchants Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1927.*"

2. *The Produce Merchants Act, 1922*, being chapter 212 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by adding as section 6*a*, immediately after section 6 thereof, the following:

"6*a*.—(1) Where the Minister is satisfied that any produce merchant or any class of produce merchants uniformly conducts his or its business upon a cash basis, he may grant such produce merchant or such class of produce merchants exemption from the provisions of this Act relating to a bond, and may at any time withdraw such exemption.

"(2) Where it appears to the Minister that any corporation, society or person is acting or about to act in such a manner as to come within the provisions of this Act, but that such action is not within the mischief of this Act, i.e., is not likely to result in loss to or the over-reaching of producers, he may grant such corporation, society or person exemption from the provisions of this Act, and may at any time withdraw such exemption."
