An Act to amend The Dairymen's Act.

(Assented to _____, 1927.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Dairymen's Act Amendment Act, 1927.*"

2. *The Dairymen's Act*, being chapter 162 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 14 thereof, by adding thereto the following proviso:

"Provided that any association registered under this Act may by its rules provide that each member shall have one vote only."

3. Section 38 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (4) thereof, by inserting after the word "weighers," the words "and he may also assess the owner of every other creamery, cheese factory or dairy, with a reasonable proportion of the cost of the supervision of graders, testers and weighers, under this Act."

4. Section 43 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (2) thereof, by adding thereto the following proviso:

"Provided further, that during the currency of a license authorizing the operation of a creamery or cheese factory, the Minister may, upon receipt of application, grant a written permit to the licensee to transfer or forward any milk or cream purchased from patrons at such creamery or cheese factory to another point to be manufactured or re-sold."

5. Section 47 of the said Act is amended—

(a) as to subsection (1) thereof, by inserting after the word "time," the words "and place";

(b) as to subsection (2) thereof by striking out the words "the cost of such transportation" and inserting in lieu thereof, the words "the excess, if any, of the actual cost of transportation over the cost of transportation if and when such cost is fixed by the Minister, under the provisions of the following subsection";

(c) by adding as subsection (2a), immediately after subsection (2) thereof, the following:

"(2a) The Minister may draw up a tariff of costs for such transportation, based upon the size of the cans used and the distance for which they are carried."

6. This Act shall come into force.....
