An Act to amend The Mothers' Allowance Act.

(Assented to , 1927.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Mothers' Allowance Act Amendment Act, 1927.*"

2. *The Mothers' Allowance Act*, being chapter 215 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 11, subsection (1), by striking out the words "ceasing to be a resident of the municipality or otherwise" where the same occur therein.

3. Section 12 of the said Act is amended—

(a) as to subsection (2) thereof, by striking out the words "unless and until she shall have become a resident of some other municipality under the provisions of the first subsection of this section";

(b) by adding thereto as subsections (3) and (4), the following:

"(3) A woman to whom an allowance is hereafter granted whilst a resident of a municipality shall be deemed to be a resident of that municipality for the purpose of this Act so long as she shall remain or be in the Province.

"(4) Every woman being upon the first day of April, 1926, in receipt of an allowance shall be deemed to be a resident of the municipality of which she was a resident immediately before the said day so long as she shall remain or be in the Province."
