An Act to amend The Trustee Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Trustee Act Amendment Act, 1927."
- **2.** The Trustee Act, being chapter 220 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by inserting immediately after section 22, the following as section 22a:
- "22a. Any person or corporation being a trustee of graingrowing property may, in lieu of marketing the grain grown on such property personally, become a member of a company or association formed for the purpose of buying and selling and marketing grain on the non-profit co-operative plan and may enter into a contract with the company or association for marketing all grain grown upon the property through such company or association and further may enter into any such contract, notwithstanding that it provides for the retention from the purchase price of the grain of a certain sum or percentage to provide a reserve fund or elevators or other facilities for handling the commodities in which the company or association deal."
