

# BILL

No. 86 of 1927.

An Act to amend The Tax Recovery Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1927.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Tax Recovery Act Amendment Act, 1927.*"

2. *The Tax Recovery Act*, being chapter 20 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1919, is amended as to section 45 by adding as subsection (2) thereof, the following:

"(2) Whenever any such balance of the proceeds of the sale of a parcel of land remains unclaimed for a period of three years from the day of the sale of such parcel, such balance shall become the property of the municipality within which the said parcel is situated, or of the Crown if the parcel is situated within an improvement district, and shall form part of the general revenue of the municipality or of the Province, as the case may be."
