No. 94 of 1927.

An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Year Ending December 31st, 1926, for the Year Ending December 31st, 1927, and for the Three Months Ending March 31st, 1928.

(Assented to _____, 1927.)

Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour William Egbert, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, the thirty-first day of December one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Appropriation Act, 1927.*"

2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole eight hundred and ninety-six thousand, five hundred and four dollars and thirty-three cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.

3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole—

(a) Twenty-one million, nine hundred and fifty thousand, three hundred and fifty-three dollars and five cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

(b) Five million and sixty-six thousand, seven hundred and fifty-four dollars and twenty-one cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule C to this Act.

4. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

5. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
