An Act to amend The Bee Diseases Act, 1924.

(Assented to _____, 1928.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Bee Diseases Act, 1924, Amendment Act, 1928.*"

2. *The Bee Diseases Act, 1924*, being chapter 21 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, is amended as to section 3 thereof—

- (a) by striking out the words "Every keeper of bees within the Province shall register with the Minister" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Every keeper of bees within the Province shall register annually with the Minister"; and
- (b) by adding thereto, as subsection (2) thereof, the following:

“(2) Such registration shall be effected prior to the fifteenth day of January, or within two weeks of commencing business, as the case may be.”
