An Act to amend The Improvement Districts Act, 1927.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Improvement Districts Act, 1927, Amendment Act, 1928."

2. The Improvement Districts Act, 1927, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, is amended as to section 2, by striking out of paragraph (h) thereof, the words "or used by some person for trade or business purposes, other than farm purposes," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "and any parcel of land occupied by a building and its appurtenances used for trade or business purposes other than farming purposes."

3. Section 12 of the said Act is amended as to subsection
(1) thereof, by adding thereto the following proviso:
"Provided, however, that parcels within a hamlet, the

"Provided, however, that parcels within a hamlet, the value of the buildings and improvements upon which has not been included in the assessment thereof in the previous year, shall be re-assessed in accordance with the provisions of this Act."

4. Section 28a is added to the said Act, immediately after section 28, as follows:

"SPECIAL ASSESSMENT.

"28a. The Minister may at any time direct a new annual or quinquennial assessment to be made in any improvement district or districts, or all improvement districts, in lieu of any assessment made in pursuance of this Act, and if in his opinion the procedure prescribed in this Act is inapplicable he may prescribe other procedure which shall include provisions for the hearing of complaints by a court of revision and the hearing of appeals by a District Court judge."
