An Act to amend The Conditional Sales Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1928).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as “*The Conditional Sales Act Amendment Act, 1928.*”
- 2. *The Conditional Sales Act*, being chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by adding as section 8*a* immediately after section 8 thereof, the following:  
“8*a*. A valid assignment of a lien note or conditional sale agreement shall transfer the assignor’s property in the goods therein comprised, his rights of seizure, removal and sale and all other rights with regard to the enforcement of the security possessed by him, and shall not require registration under the provisions of *The Bills of Sale Act.*”
- 3. This Act shall come into force on.....
