No. 45 of 1928.

An Act to amend The Private Hospitals Act.

(Assented to _____, 1928).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Private Hospitals Act Amendment Act, 1928.*"

2. *The Private Hospitals Act*, being chapter 41 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1925, is amended as to section 2 thereof, by adding thereto as paragraph (aa) immediately after paragraph (a) thereof, the following:

"(aa) 'Births' shall include still births."

3. Section 4 of the said Act is hereby struck out and the following substituted therefor:

"4. Every application for a license to keep a private hospital shall—

"(a) be in writing;

"(b) be accompanied by a plan of the hospital building;

"(c) indicate the character or class of the hospital for which a license is required; and

"(d) be accompanied by a fee of ten dollars, or such lower fee as may in any particular case be prescribed by the Minister."

4. Section 5 of the said Act is amended by striking out paragraph (a) thereof, and substituting therefor the following:

"(a) shall state for what purposes the private hospital is licensed."

5. Section 11 of the said Act is amended—

(a) by adding after the word "superintendent" wherever it occurs therein, the words "or if there is no superintendent, the licensee"; and

(b) by adding thereto as subsections (4) and (5) thereof, the following:

"(4) The superintendent, or if there is no superintendent, the licensee, of every private hospital shall not later than the tenth day of each month, make a return to the Provincial Board of all births which have taken place in the hospital during the preceding month; and such return shall be in such form and shall contain such particulars as the Provincial Board may from time to time require.

"(5) The superintendent, or if there is no superintendent, the licensee, of every private hospital shall, as soon as possible, send a full report of every death occurring in a private hospital to the Provincial Board, and in the case of the death of any mother or child in a maternity home, such report shall be forwarded within twenty-four hours of the death."

6. Section 13 of the said Act is hereby struck out.
