An Act to amend The Solemnization of Marriage Act.

(Assented to _____, 1928).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Solemnization of Marriage Act Amendment Act, 1928.*"

2. *The Solemnization of Marriage Act*, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1925, is amended as to section 19 thereof by adding thereto, as subsection (4), the following:

"(4) If the issuer is in the public service of the Province he shall not be entitled to retain any part of the fee unless the contrary is prescribed by order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and then only to the extent and subject to the conditions set out in such order."

3. Section 23 of the said Act is amended by adding thereto as subsection (3) thereof, the following:

"(3) In case both the parties to an intended marriage are Indians living on a reserve, subsection (1) of this section shall be read and construed as if the word 'fourteen' were substituted for the word 'sixteen' wherever the same occurs therein."
