An Act to amend The Public Vehicles Act, 1927.

(Assented to , 1928.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Public Vehicles Act, 1927, Amendment Act, 1928."

2. The Public Vehicles Act, 1927, being chapter 63 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, is amended by adding as section 6a, immediately after section 6 thereof, the following:

"6a. Any license or permit under the provisions of this Act shall entitle the holder thereof to operate his vehicle in or through any town or village upon the specified route, without holding any license from such town or village."

3. Section 17 of the said Act is hereby struck out and the following substituted therefor:

"17.—(1) Every owner of a public or freight vehicle shall keep on foot a policy, bond of indemnity or other insurance against such one or more of the following matters as the Lieutenant Governor in Council may prescribe:

- '(a) against injuries to persons and loss of or damage to property resulting from the operation of his vehicle or vehicles;
- "(b) against injury to freight or loss thereof in respect of which he is legally liable;
- "(c) against loss resulting from failure on his part or that of any of his employees to pay over or account for any money received for freight from any consignee.

"(2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may from time to time fix the amounts of such insurance and the form in which it is to be effected, and for that purpose may classify— "(a) public and freight vehicles; and

"(b) the owners thereof

and may base such classifications upon the size, weight, and equipment or the use made of such vehicles or upon any one or more of such matters and upon the nature of the business of the owner, respectively, and may, in fixing such amounts, differentiate between vehicles and owners of different classes."
