An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fifteen Months Ending March 31st, 1928, and for the Year Ending March 31st, 1929.

Most Gracious Sovereign:

W HEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour William Egbert, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, 1928."
- 2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole five million, nine hundred and twenty-four thousand, nine hundred and twenty-three dollars and forty-two cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven to the thirty-first day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.
- 3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole twenty-five million, two hundred and nine thousand, five hundred and twenty-one dollars and seven cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April in the year of Our Lord

one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight to the thirty-first day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

- 4. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
- 5. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
