H^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. An Act to Incorporate the Central Canada Railway Company, being chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1913, is amended as to subsection (1) of section 6 thereof, by striking out all the words after the word "meridian" where it occurs for the second time, and substituting therefor the words "thence in a generally northerly and westerly direction along the north side of the Peace River to a point on the westerly boundary of the Province in Townships eightyfour or eighty-five; also a branch line from a point at or near Grimshaw in a generally northerly direction to a point that will, when surveyed, approximate to a point in Township one hundred and eleven, Range nineteen or twenty, west of the fifth principal meridian; thence in a generally northerly direction approximately parallel to the Hay River to the northern boundary of the Province."
