An Act to amend The Minimum Wage Act, 1925.

(Assented to , 1928.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Minimum Wage Act, 1925, Amendment Act, 1928.*"
- 2.** *The Minimum Wage Act, 1925*, being chapter 23 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1925, is amended as to section 2 by striking out of paragraph (f) thereof the words "responsible directly or indirectly for the payment of wages to an employee" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "employing for himself or for another, any employee."
- 3.** Section 7 of the said Act is amended—
 - (a) as to subsection (1) thereof, by striking out the words "at a rate of wages less than that fixed therein," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "without paying to them wages at a rate not less than that specified therein, and may make such order, whether the employer affected thereby does or does not at the date thereof, pay any wages to such employee, or gives or does not give instruction to such employee"; and
 - (b) by adding as subsection (10a) immediately after subsection (10) thereof, the following:
"(10a) In any case where any person has been employed by her employer in any branch of work in any trade or occupation at the minimum wage, the Board shall have power to permit that employer to employ her in another branch of work of the same trade or occupation at such rate less than the minimum rate of wages and for such time as may be determined by the Board."
