## An Act to amend The Boilers Act.

(Assented to

, 1928.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Boilers Act Amendment Act, 1928."
- 2. The Boilers Act, being chapter 191 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 6, subsection (1), by striking out the words "shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than fifty dollars," and substituting therefor the words "shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars."
- 3. Section 40 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (1) thereof, by striking out the words "The employer of any person," and substituting therefor the words "Every owner employing any person."
- 4. Section 47 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (1) thereof, by striking out the words "to the holder or holders of a final engineer's certificate," and substituting therefor the words "to a qualified engineer or qualified engineers."
- 5. Section 60 of the said Act is amended by striking out the words "shall on summary conviction thereof be liable to a penalty of not more than one hundred dollars," and substituting therefor the words "shall on summary conviction thereof be liable to a penalty of not less than ten dollars and not more than one hundred dollars."
