An Act to amend The Municipal Ordinance.

(Assented to _____, 1928.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Municipal Ordinance Amendment Act, 1928.*"

2. *The Municipal Ordinance*, being chapter 70 of the Consolidated Ordinances of the North-West Territories of Canada, 1898, is amended by striking out section 156 thereof, and substituting therefor the following:

"**156.** In the event of any taxes remaining unpaid after the thirty-first day of December of the year for which the same are levied, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty a sum equal to five per centum of the amount of taxes remaining unpaid, and in the event of any such taxes or penalties or any part thereof remaining unpaid on the first day of July next following, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty an additional sum equal to five per centum of the amount of such taxes and penalties at that date remaining unpaid, and in like manner there shall be added five per cent of any such taxes or penalties remaining unpaid half-yearly on the first days of January and July in each year following; and such amount or amounts so added shall form a part of the taxes which are created a special lien upon the land under the provisions of this Ordinance; but nothing in this section contained shall be construed to extend the time for payment of the said taxes, nor in any way to impair the right of distress or any other remedy which is provided by this Ordinance for the collection of the said taxes."
