An Act respecting The Industrial Disputes Investigation Act of Canada and Labour Disputes within the Jurisdiction of the Province.

WHEREAS the provisions of *The Industrial Disputes* Investigation Act, being chapter 112 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1927, do not apply to industrial disputes which are within the exclusive legislative jurisdiction of any Province of Canada, except only any dispute which is within the exclusive legislative jurisdiction of any Province and which by the legislation of the Province is made subject to the provisions thereof; and

Whereas it is deemed expedient that the provisions of the said Act shall be made to apply to industrial disputes of the nature defined in the said Act which are within the exclusive legislative jurisdiction of the Province;

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE.

1. This Act may be cited as "The Industrial Disputes Investigation Act (Alberta), 1928."

APPLICATION OF ACT.

- 2. The provisions of *The Industrial Disputes Investigation Act*, being chapter 112 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1927, shall apply to every industrial dispute of the nature therein defined which is within or subject to the exclusive legislative jurisdiction of the Province.
- 3. The Lieutenant Governor may, by Proclamation, apply the provisions of any amendment to the said Act which may hereafter be enacted by the Parliament of Canada to every industrial dispute of the nature in the said Act defined which is within or subject to the exclusive legislative jurisdiction of the Province, whereupon those provisions shall apply accordingly.
- 4. The Labour Disputes Act, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1926, is amended as to section 3 thereof by adding at the end the following words: "and which have not been made subject to the provisions of The Industrial Disputes Investigation Act of Canada."
- 5. This Act shall come into force upon Proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
