# BILL

No. 21 of 1923.

An Act to amend The Woodmen's Lien Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1923.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Woodmen's Lien Act Amendment Act, 1923.*"

2. *The Woodmen's Lien Act*, being chapter 165 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 7, subsection (1), by adding at the end thereof, the following: "and a copy of said statement is served upon the defendant, and if the defendant is not the owner of the said logs, timber or lumber, then a copy of the statement is also served upon the owner of the said logs, timber, or lumber, or upon the agent or person in whose possession, custody or control they may be found."
