A BILL TO AMEND THE GAME ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill—

- (1) permits the hunting of bear under a big game license during the open season without also purchasing a resident trapper's license; and
- (2) defines what is meant by the "house" of a muskrat or beaver; and
- (3) gives power to a convicting justice to cancel the license of an offender.

## BILL

No. 26 of 1929.

An Act to amend The Game Act.

(Assented to , 1929.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Game Act Amendment Act, 1929.*"

2. *The Game Act*, being chapter 70 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 2 thereof, by inserting as paragraph (ii) immediately after paragraph (i), the following:

"(ii) 'house' shall mean any shelter that has been constructed by a muskrat or beaver, for the purpose of feeding, resting or sleeping therein."

3. Section 4 of the said Act is amended—

(a) as to subsection (1) thereof, by adding thereto the following paragraphs:

"(f) any bear between the fifteenth day of June and the first day of September;

"(g) any bear with a cub or cubs, at any time;

"(h) any bear cub at any time"; and

(b) by adding thereto the following new subsection:

"(3) No person shall during any one open season take or kill more than one of any species of bear."

4. Section 5 of the said Act is amended—

(a) as to subsection (1) thereof, by striking out paragraphs (e), (f) and (g) thereof; and

(b) by striking out subsection (7) thereof.

5. Section 50a is added to the said Act immediately after section 50 thereof, as follows:

"50a. Whenever any licensee is convicted of an offence against any of the provisions of this Act, the convicting justice may direct that the said license shall be cancelled, and thereupon it shall be delivered to the convicting justice, to be forwarded to the Department, and no other license shall be issued to such licensee during the current year."
