## A BILL TO AMEND THE CO-OPERATIVE MARKETING ASSOCIATIONS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill—

- (a) permits persons engaged in the industry of fishing to incorporate under the Act;
- (b) provides a method of winding-up co-operative marletting associations; and
- (c) permits co-operative associations incorporated under The Co-operative Associations Act, engaged in marketing agricultural products to register upder this Act.

## BILL.

No. 27 of 1929.

An Act to amend The Co-operative Marketing Associations Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta. enacts as follows:

- This Act may be cited as "The Co-operative Marketing Associations Act. Amendment Act. 1989."
- 2. The Co-sucretive Markeline Associations Act. being chapter 5 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, is amended as to meeting 3 thereof, by inserting after the words "agricultural products" the words "or fish."
  - Section 14, subsection (1), of the said Act is amended as to paragraph (a) thereof, by inserting after the words "utilization of" the words "fish or."
  - Section 20 of the said Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the words "persons engaged in the industry of fishing, and any association to which this Act autilies."
  - 5. Section 26 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (1) by adding at the end thereof the words "or in fishing."
  - 6. Section 46s is added to the said Act immediately after section 46, as follows: "-16a.--(1) An association under this Act may be dis-
  - solved in either of the ways following, namely:
    - "(a) By filing with the registrar an instrument of dis-solution, executed by not less than two-thirds of the members of the association, which shall con-
      - "(i) a statement that it is desirable to dissolve the association;
        "(ii) it Statement in detail of the assets and liabili-
      - ties of the association;
      - "(iii) the names and fast known addresses of all the members of the association, a detailed list of the creditors of the association, together with the amount of each creditor's claim, and with the instrument of dissolution shall be filed one

or more sufficient affidavits verifying the execution of the said instrument and the truth of the statements therein contained; or
