## An Act to amend The Optometry Act.

(Assented to . 1929.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of

The Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

This Act may be eited as "The Optometry Act Amendment Act, 1929."

 The Optometry Act, being chapter 77 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1921, is amended by striking out section 2 thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"2.—(1) Any one, or any combination of, the following practices constitutes the practice of unionstry:

"(a) The examination of the human eye by the employment of subjective or objective means to ascertain the presence of defects or abnormal conditions which, or the effect of which, may be corrected, reflected or remedied by the use of buses, prisans,

"(b) The employment of objective or subjective machanical aparas to determine the accommodative or refractive conditions of the human eye or the range of the noneres of vision of the human eye.

"(e) The powers of vessel in the instance (e.,

"(e) The prescription or adeptation of leases or prising

"(d) The replacement, displication, sale or supplying of

an opidinalistic lens without a prescription from a person authorized under the larse of this Province to practise either optometry or medicina or surgery. The provisions of this purregraph shall not be construct so as to prevent as optical mechanic from deling the merely insolution work in such a case. "(3) An 'ophthelatic lens' within the meaning of this
