An Act to amend The Irrigation Districts Act

HIS MAJESTY, by usel with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, emets as follows:

- This Act may be cited as "The Irrigation Districts
 Act Amendment Act, 1929."
 - The Irrigation Districts Act, being chapter 114 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 145 thereof, by adding to paragraph (c) the following new clause:
