An Act respecting the University of Alberta Hospital.

(Associated to , 1929.)

WHEREAS, the hospital known as the University of Alberta Hospital is, under the provisions of chapter 27 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, vested in the Goorenars of the University of Alberta (hereinafter called "the Gor-

ernors"); and

Whereas, certain payments on the part of the City to the
said Governors are therein provided for; and

Whereas, it seems desirable that the said hospital should be vested in the bedy corporate (hereinafter created), and that provision for the management of the said hospital should be made;

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, coacts as follows:

 This Act may be cited as "The University of Alberta Hospital Act, 1920."

 There shall be a Board of Management of the said hospital which shall be a body corporate, and shall be known as "the University Hospital Board" (hereinafter called "the Board").

 The Board shall consist of such even number of members, not less than six and not more than tirelye, as may be from time to time prescribed by order of the Lioutenant Governor in Council.

4.—(1) One-half in number of such members shall be appointed by the Governoor of the University of Albert, and the other half by the Lieutenut Governor in Council. (2) The members of the Board shall hold offer for such term or terms of office as may from three to time be prescribed by the Lieutenut, Governor in Council.

5. The Board shall annually elect one of its members to be chairman.

6. The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall from time to time pay to the said Board such sums of money as may seen pruper, out of such funds as may be voted for that purpose by the Legislative Amenbly. 7. The suggested control and government of the property and affairs of the hospital shall be vested in the Board, and affairs of the hospital shall be vested in the Board, which, without restriction of the interpretation as a Board for the persons of carrying on and administrating a hospital for the care and treatment of the sick, and for the provision of obtactional facilities to students of medicine, surgery and individual control in horse declared to be incorporated with individual matters, is harder declared to be incorporated with

(a) To take over the whole of the property of and in the University of Alberta Hospital;

(a) To provide facilities for proper modern altimatance, matring, food and medicine, and all things and appliances of a medical survived dictricin and surfixery

character, and in addition thereto all the conforts and advantages of home in various degrees, according to the payments made by the patients; (d) To employ medical, surgical and pharascentical officers, nurses and attendants for the purposes aforesaid, and to provide and supply all such medical, surgical and pharascentical applainances and

eal, surgical and plantasaccetical appliances and things, and all such provisions and necessaries as may be required for the purposes aforeand or any of them;

(e) To educate and train needical students and nurses;

(e) To educate and train medical students and nurses;
 (f) To purchase or otherwise sequire land for any estate or interest;

(g) With the consent of the Licutenant Governor-in Council, previously given, to raise messey for any of the alyee purposes and to acquire the same in such meaner as the Based shall think fit, and in particular, by the Issue of debestures or detecture stock, perpental or otherwise, charged upon all of the council of securities;

(a) To accept salteeriptions and donations (whether of real or personal estate), and devises and bequests, for all or any of the purposes aforsasid, and to sell und dispose of, and to manage all real estate so received and not required to be, or capable of being, occupied for the purposes of the hospital or no.

- such medical school or nursing institute as aforesaid; and generally to manage, invest and expend all moneys and property belonging to the hospital;
- To exercise all such other powers as may be conferred upon it by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
- S. All appointments to the clinical staff of the said basipital shall be made by the Board only after consolitation with the Governous, and all appointments to the teaching faculty of the University of persons to becture, teach or otherwise instruct in the said hospital, shall only be made after consultation with the Pouvil.
- 9.—(1) The said loopids shall be framefered by the Governors to the Board upon such terms and together with said appartenances, premises and parteels of laud at may be agreed upon between the Governors and the Board and approved of by Order is Cessell or in default of agreement, may be determined upon by Order in Council.

 (2) All contracts, obligations, delice, vigitis, powers and privileges entered into, immunicat upon, possessed or emoyed by the Governous of the University of Alberta, in respect of the anid hospital are hereby declaved to be binding upon or vested in the Board.
- J0.—(1) The prevents of the Board shall be unde up to the 15th that of March in early year, and at such other times as may be determined by the Liceteand Governor in Council; and in every such case the Board shall prepare a financial statement and submit the same to the Previncial Auditor for his critification.
- (2) All books and records perfaining to the work carried on by the Board under this Act, shall be of all times subject to examination and andit by the Provincial Auditor or by such other person as the Lieutenant Governor in Conneil may autherize in that telestic.
- (3) The Board shall annually make a report to the Lignizant Georence in Coupel for the twelve months ending the 21st stay of March of the facel warr in respect of which the report is made, which shall contain a statement of receive and expenditure and a statement of mosts and liabilities for the foscil year immediately preceding; and the statement, an certified by the Provincial Antifore, shall be included in the Public Accounts for the year.
 - (4) The Lieutemant Governor in Council shall have power, upon the recommendation of the Provincial Anditor, to prescribe the form of the necessate to be kept by the Board in anywise relating to the matters dealt with by this Act.
 - (5) All venebers covering payment of services rendered or supplies farmished stail be certified by the Provincial Auditor before being paid.

- 11. The annual report to the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall be made at such time as may be prescribed by him, and such report shall be laid upon the table of the Ilouze at the session of the Legislative Assembly next cassing after its receipt.
- 12. The Board may make regulations respecting the administration of the affairs of the bospital, which regulations upon being confirmed by the Lieutenan Governor in Council, shall have the same force as if set out in detail herein.
