A BILL TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.

(Assented to 1920.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

This Act may be eited as "The Public Health Act.

The Public Health Act, being chapter 58 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by adding thereto, immediately after section 22, the following new sections:
