An Act to amend The Live Stock Encouragement Act,

(Assented to . 1929.)

[4] 18 MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enaeta as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Live Stock Encouragement Act Amendment Act, 1929."

2. The Live Stock Encouragement Act, being chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 2 thereof-

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) thereof, and substituting therefor the following: "(b) 'Commissioner' shall mean the Deputy Minister of Municipal Affairs, or other person

duly appointed as commissioner; (b) by striking out of paragraph (c) thereof the words "Department of Agriculture" and substituting therefor the words "Department of Municipal

Affairs"; and (c) by striking out of paragraph (c) thereof the words "Minister of Agriculture" and substituting therefor the words "Minister of Municipal Affairs."

3. Section 16 of the said Act is amended by striking out the words "upon all the real and personal property within the Province of every purchaser," and substituting therefor the words "upon all the real and personal property owned by the purchaser at the time of the note being given or suisomestly acquired by him."

4. Section 11 of the said Act is amended-

(a) as to subsection (1) thereof, by striking out all the words after the words "real and personal property" and substituting therefor the words "lw his swent. without any further or other authority than is given by this section:" and

(b) by striking out subsection (4) thereof, and substituting therefor the following: "(4) If the proceeds of the sale are more than sufficient to discharge the liability of the said pur-
