An Act to Amend The Mental Defectives Act

(Assented to _____, 1929.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Mental Defectives Act Amendment Act, 1929.*"

2. *The Mental Defectives Act*, being chapter 224 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 4 thereof, by adding thereto the following proviso:

"Provided, however, that any mentally defective person may, upon application of the Superintendent, made under the provisions of this Act, be committed to the charge of some person in a private dwelling-house, and upon such commitment being made, the said dwelling-house shall be considered to be an institution established under this Act, and all the provisions of this Act shall apply to such defective and house, save that the charges for maintenance for such defective shall be such monthly sums as the Minister may direct."

3. Section 156 is added to the said Act, as follows:

"156. Rules of Court may be made under the provisions of section 38 of *The Judicature Act*, providing for the appointment of a guardian to the estate of a person who is of unsound mind, whether he is so by reason of disease or natural deficiency."
