HiS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, engets as follows:

This Act may be cited as "The Sale of Gusoline Requisition Act."

2. No person who sells any gazoline for delivery within the Province otherwise than to a reader of gazoline or for delivery into the gazoline bank affixed to any gazoline-prapelled vehicle or automobile, shall deliver the same subest the container in which such gazoline is said is marked with the word "Caroline" or has firmly tied thereto a lated besting that word.

 Every person who contraveness the provisions of this Act shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable upon summany conviction to a penalty of not more than fifty dollars and costs, or in default of payment to imprisonment for one month.
