HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Lagislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, contens as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Electrical Protection And Amendment Act, 1922."

 The Electrical Protection Act, being chapter 192 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by striking out section 3 thereof, and substituting therefor the fol-

"(r) providing for plate and specifications governing the design, construction and test of any of the works or natters hereinbefore mentioned, and the amendment or afternation of any such plans and specifications: "(f) relating to work to be done in the installation, remeral, alteration, regair, protection, connection, or disconnection of any of the works or matters hereinbefore mentioned, as may be deemed necessary for the safety of the public, or of workners, or for the
