## An Act respecting Water Powers.

## (Assented to , 1920.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Atberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Weter Powers Act."

2. The member of the Executive General who may be appointed thermatic by the Liquenzate Generate in Council scalar have the administration and management of all the water and water power, the property in which or the right to administration which is or may benefate by voteful in the Province, and the right to control and regulate the distribution of such water cover throughouth to province.

 The Lieutennut Governor in Council may appoint such officers as may from time to time be required for the administrution of this Act.

4. The Lieutenard Governor is Council shall have power for preservice regulations reparating all such water ov water power and such regulations shall have the same force and effect as if not out herein, but shall be laid upon the table of the Legislative Assembly, at the ossion next ensuing, after the making thereof, and shall, if then distillowed, coset to have any whility instancever.

5. Utili may nech regulations are made, and in so far as any regulations lawfully made under anthonyli debated from the banission of Canada or otherwise, do not conflict therwish, the purvisions of *The Danislow* Utilitar Perser Act, bring chapter 210 of the Danislow Statutes of Canada, 1027, and such other Act of the Danislow of Canada, as hardworks, apply to and Council may require, shall, weighter the danisli, apply to and council and ratic power and the minimization theorem.
