An Act to amend The Coal Miners' Wages Security Act.

(Assented to _____, 1930).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Coal Miners' Wages Security Act Amendment Act, 1930.*"

2. *The Coal Miners' Wages Security Act*, being chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1928, is amended as to section 4 thereof, by adding thereto, as subsection (4), the following:

"(4) If a mine is not in operation on or before the first day of June in any year, and it is proposed to commence the operation of such mine at any time between the first day of June in that year and the first day of June in the next following year, the mine-owner shall comply with all the requirements of this Act as to the making of returns and the furnishing of a bond or other security before he commences to operate his mine with hired employees."

3. This Act shall come into force upon the day it is assented to.
