## An Act to amend The Auctioneers and Pedlers' Act.

(Assented to , 1930.)

**H**<sup>IS</sup> MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Auctioneers and Pedlers' Act Amendment Act, 1930."

**2.** The Auctioneers and Pedlers' Act, being chapter 39 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 6 thereof, by adding thereto the following subsections:

"(2) A licence may be issued authorizing a hawker or pedler to hawk, peddle or sell goods, wares or merchandise, the growth, produce or manufacture of Alberta.

"(3) When any such licence has been issued to any person no municipal license shall be required for hawking, peddling or selling such goods by the manufacturer or producer of them, or by his *bona fide* servants or employees having written authority to do so. "(4) Such servant or employee shall exhibit his authority

"(4) Such servant or employee shall exhibit his authority when required so to do by any municipal or peace officer."(5) In a prosecution for the breach of any municipal

"(5) In a prosecution for the breach of any municipal by-law requiring a licence for hawkers or pedlers, the onus of proving that he does not by virtue of this section require to be licenced, shall be upon the person charged." No. 39.
