An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to

, 1930.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act, 1930."
- **2.** The Legislative Assembly Act, being chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 2 thereof, by striking out the word "sixty" and substituting therefor the word "sixty-three."
- **3.** Section 3 of the said Act is hereby struck out and the following substituted therefor:
- "3. Each of the Electoral Divisions nominated, defined or constituted in or by Schedule 1 of this Act shall return one member, except the Electoral Divisions of Edmonton and Calgary, which shall each return six members."
- **4.** Section 36 of the said Act is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "36. There shall be paid to the Speaker and Deputy Speaker such allowances as may be voted by the Legislative Assembly."
- **5.** Schedule 1 to the said Act is hereby repealed and the Schedule to this Act substituted therefor.
- **6.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
