An Act to amend The Stock Inspection Act, 1922.

(Assented to 1930)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Stock Inspection Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1930".

2. The Stock Inspection Act, being chapter 69 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 2 thereof, by adding as paragraph (bb), immediately after paragraph (b) thereof, the following:

"(bb) "Butcher" shall mean any person carrying on the business of dealer in the flesh of cattle, sheep, pigs or poultry (hereinafter called 'meat animals')"

3. Section 14 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (1) thereof, by striking out the words "every other person dealing in the purchase and sale of hides" and substituting therefor the words "every dealer in hides".

4. Section 15 of the said Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"15.--(1) Every butcher shall keep a record of all meat animals slaughtered by him or at his direction or purchased by him, naming therein the person from whom the meat animals were obtained and his place of residence and the age, sex, brands (if any) and markings of any such meat animals."

5. Form D in the Schedule to the said Act is amended by adding thereto the following:

"OR

"Under and by virtue of the power vested in the Minister of Agriculture under The Stock Inspection Act, 1922, of the Province of Alberta, of, in the is hereby authorized to engage in business as a butcher under the provisions of the law in that respect, between the day of and the thirty-first day of December, 19.....
