An Act respecting Unemployment Relief

(Assented to , 1981.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberts, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Unemployment Relief Act."

- 7. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
