## BILL

An Act respecting Arrears of Drainage Rates in Diamage Distracts

(Assented to . 1931 )

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

1. This Act may be cited as "The Drainage Rotes Arreais Act"

 In this Act, unless the context requires a contrary meaning, the expression "parcel" means a parcel of land as defined in The Drawage Districts Act, being chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922.

3. 4. Upon any such by-law being approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, any sale enforcement proceedings under The Drawings Districts Act in respect of such an ears shall be suspended.

5. The Board shall add to the amount of the ordinary annual draunger rates or respect of any parcel the amount of such installments of arreas with respect to such parcel, together with interest, and thereupon the total amount of the ordinary rates and the sums or added shall constitute the rate payable in expect of such parcel within the meaning of The Draunage Durinets Act and all the provisions of that Act relating to rate enforcement shall apply thereto.

6. If at any time default is made in the payment of the current dramage rates in respect of any partel lo which this Act applies, the whole of the arrears of dramage rates, including any arrars of rates in respect of such partel payable by installments pursuant to a by-law, shall become due and payable forthwith, and all the remodes provided by The Dramage Districts Act for sale enforcement shall be returned.

7. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
