No. 34 of 1931

An Act to amend The Town Act, 1927.

(Assented to , 1931.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Town Act, 1927, Amendment Act, 1931*."

2. *The Town Act, 1927*, being chapter 55 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1927, is hereby amended as to section 153 thereof—

(a) by striking out paragraph (c) of subsection (3) and by substituting therefor the following

"(c) 'Resident' means—

"(i) any person who has had his home in the town for at least three successive months of the six months immediately preceding the date of his application to the council for assistance, or the date of his application to the council for admission to a hospital, as the case may be; and

"(ii) any person not having had a home as last aforesaid, who has been a sojourner within the town for at least three successive months of the six months immediately preceding the date of his application to the council for assistance, or the date of his application to the council for admission to a hospital, as the case may be;

"Provided always that any such person had, at the date of such application, no permanent home elsewhere than in the Province."

(b) by striking out subsection (6) thereof and by substituting therefor the following

"(6) Any member of the council, and the secretary-treasurer of the council, may sign and issue any of the written orders mentioned in this section on behalf of the council of which he is a member or by which he is employed, as the case may be."

(c) by striking out subsection (11) thereof and by substituting therefor the following

"(11) In any case in which a town has granted relief under this Act or *The Hospitals Act* to any person resident in the town in respect of whom the

town is legally chargeable on account of such relief, the liability of the town under the said Acts shall continue so long as such relief is either paid or payable, and for three months after the discontinuance thereof."

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 252 thereof by adding at the end of subsection (1) the following: "and may fix a different rate of taxation with respect to each of any business, trade, or profession."

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 293 thereof by striking out the same

5. The said Act is further amended as to subsection (2) of section 362 thereof by striking out the words "businesses and personal property" where the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the words "and businesses"

6. The said Act is further amended as to section 366 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following:

"(11) The council may by resolution rebate the whole or part of any frontage tax assessed and chargeable pursuant to this section in respect of any parcel of land upon which there are buildings which are connected with the water-works mains."
