HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows.

1. This Act muy be cated as "The Land Telles Act Amendment Act, 1981."

 The Land Titles Act, being chapter 183 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1932, is hereby amended as to section 30 thereof by adding at the end of the said section the following

"(7) Upon the receipt by the Registrar of a Notification affecting any land vested in the Crown in the right of the Province, issued and executed in the manner provided in any statute in force in the Province relating to the disposition of the lands first mentioned, that any parcel of such land on one careas state merinement, once may parcel of 20th indu-descubed therein or any interest in any such land has been granted to any person pursuant to such statute, such noth-cation shall be accepted by the Registrar and he dealt with by him in all respects as if the same were letters patent in favor of such person, and he shall issue a certificate of title in conformity with the terms of such notification
